

STRAWBERRY VALLEY PROJECT MAILING LIST FOR AFFECTED WATER USERS

Instructions for accessing the Division of Water Rights data base for names and addresses of water users within selected areas of the Utah Lake-Jordan River General Adjudication area.

- STEP 1: Go the Division of Water Rights home page at <http://waterrights.utah.gov>
- STEP 2: From the menu at the left of the page, click “GIS Data.”
- STEP 3: From the menu at the left of the page, click “Water Rights Maps.”
- STEP 4: Scroll down to “”Interactive Regional Maps.” From the list appearing below that heading, click “Spanish Fork Return Flow.” This brings up a screen with an interactive map on the left and a tool on the right.

Instructions to use the map page can be found by clicking the help button, which is found near the bottom of the drop-down menu at the top right of the screen.

To view an area on the interactive map, click on the overlay menu at the right of the page. For example, to view the SVP use area, click “Service.” This shows the SVP use area based on the place of use for the SVP water rights.

To change the background of the base map, click the “Base Map” drop-down menu and choose a background map. The three base maps currently available are “No Base Image,” “Topographic Maps” (the default), and “Aerial Photographs.”

To generate data for a mailing list:

1. Click the area of interest on the “Display” list., for example, “Service,” which displays the SVP service area.
2. With the area highlighted on the map, go to the upper drop-down menu (the default on this menu is “Zoom In Mode”).
3. Click the desired query matching the area highlighted on the map. For example, “Strawberry Water Users Groundwater Query.”
4. With the Query highlighted in the upper drop-down menu, click the corresponding highlighted area on the map.
5. For the shorter lists, the list will appear. For longer lists, such as “Strawberry Water Users Groundwater Query,” a screen may appear with two boxes, essentially dividing the list into two parts. The list should appear after a few moments.
6. The data list can now be saved and opened later as a mailing list in Excel or Word.

As of this date, the mailing list program is still subject to revision and correction. In addition, this list is generated from GIS data, meaning it calls up the water rights within a certain area. The surface water users from Utah Lake and the Jordan river are included in the list for “Utah Valley Surface” and “Jordan River Tributary.” If a separate mailing list for surface diversions from Utah Lake and the Jordan River is needed, it would be generated separately because it is based on source rather than geographic location.

NUMBERS OF WATER USERS

The numbers of water users in the respective areas are as follows. These numbers are preliminary, and will be decreased to account for duplicates.
