Dear Teresa:

Currently the elevation of Utah Lake is 4487.97 feet, or 1.10 feet below the compromise elevation. Therefore, Utah Lake is still below the Utah Lake Distribution Plan conversion line. It is possible that Utah Lake may cross the conversion line however if dry conditions continue to persist it is not certain.

We request that the conversion line be lowered using E4319, E3100 and E3101 as provided for in the Utah Lake Distribution Plan. We also request that you convert all CUP system storage in Deer Creek and Jordanelle reservoirs to priority storage once the conversion line has been lowered.

Re: Utah Lake Conversion Line Lowered Using E4319, E3100 and E3101

Dear Stan & John:

March 28, 2013 the State Engineer received a request from Central Utah Water Conservancy District that the Utah Lake Distribution Plan conversion line be lowered using E4319, E3100 and E3101 as provided for in the Utah Lake Distribution Plan.

These exchanges represent ~~13,624~~ 24,762.4 AF of primary rights in Utah Lake and 57,073 AF of secondary rights in Utah Lake that may be directly exchanged for sytem storage in Deer Creek and Jordanelle Reservoirs, or in accordance with the Utah Lake Distribution Plan the uses under these rights may be forgone and used to lower the Utah Lake Conversion line. ~~for which water from Strawberry Reservoir will be provided.~~ When the elevation of Utah Lake exceeds that of the conversion line, or the lowered conversion line, the criteria for ~~when~~ system storage in Utah Lake ~~has been met. /and/or/~~ System Storage in both upstream reservoirs is to be converted to priority storage.

The river commissioners are hereby directed to implement these exchanges as of March 28, 2013 and to convert all system storage in Jordanelle and Deer Creek reservoirs to priority storage.
