March 1, 2005 Water Meeting Report


Water Commissioners Report of Activity for preceding year (2004)

- 01-06-2004 Checked New Castle, Pinto Canyon shut-off tags on diversion points for compliance. (travel 85.6 miles).
- 01-09-2004 Attended Water Users Meeting Beryl, Utah
- 02-21-2004 Travel to Cedar City Office to discuss, and review complaint against Pinto Canyon Diversions
- 02-25-2004 Checked New Castle, Pinto Canyon diversion points, and shut-off tags for compliance. (travel 86.2 miles)
- 03-03-2004 Attended and reported at State Water Meeting for 2004 Beryl, Utah
- 06 -14-2004 Received another complaint about New Castle, Pinto Canyon Diversions traveled canyon and checked for compliance and referred complaint to Cedar City office. (travel 134.00 miles)
- 07-09-2004 Traveled valley with John Larsen and Kurt Vest to check underground water users for over watering. Found essentially all were in compliance except Tammy Hansen (Tammy Bosshardt) and Mont Woods.(travel in state vehicle)
- 08-10-2004 Traveled valley checking for compliance as requested by John Larsen and found conditions the same as previously on 07-09. (travel 98.5 miles)
- 08-21-2004 Traveled valley checking compliance and conditions found to be the same as previously noted. (travel 105.1 miles)

- 09-12-2004 Pinto Canyon vandalism reported to Washington County Sheriff at John Cannons diversion gate (travel 89.6 miles)
- 09-20-2004 Pinto Canyon vandalism reported to Washington County Sheriff at Ence's diversion gate (travel 88.3 miles)
- 10-13-2004 Traveled valley checking for compliance and conditions found to be the same as previously noted. (travel 101.3 miles)
- 10-18-2004 Traveled to Cedar City Office to procure shut-off tags for New Castle and Pinto diversions and received instruction on the diversion system. (travel 83.4 miles)
- 10-20-2004 Checked Pinto Canyon Diversions for compliance and vandalism.
- 11-01-2004 Attached shut off tags to diversion points in New Castle and Pinto Canyon. (travel 90.3 miles)
