

Minutes of the Annual Meeting of the Beaver River
Distribution System Users
Feb. 22, 1983

The annual meeting was held in the Commissioner's Room in the Beaver County Courthouse Feb. 22, 1983 at 1:30 p.m.

Chairman Roy Yardley called the meeting to order. Secretary Earl T. Smith read the minutes of the 1982 meeting. It was moved and seconded that the minutes be accepted as read. Mr. Yardley then turned the meeting over to Donald D Norseth.

Mr. Norseth stated that the snow pack was better in the southern part of the state than in the northern part. He said it looked like it would be a very good year for us. He then gave the financial report. Robert Christiansen moved that the report be accepted as read. Wayne Wiseman seconded the motion and it was carried.

Lee Strong gave the commissioner's report. A copy was given to the chairman and the secretary. Robert Christiansen made a motion that the report be accepted and Wayne Wiseman seconded the motion. The group accepted it by vote.

The commissioner's salary was set at \$4828.39 with a retirement of \$951.21. A motion was made by Evan Patterson that the commissioner's salary remain the same as it was last year with the water users paying the commissioner's retirement in the amount set by the state. Robert Christiansen seconded the motion and it was carried by the vote of the group.

Since Lee Strong's was the only application submitted for water commissioner, it was moved by Robert Christiansen that the rule be dropped for this year and Lee Strong be accepted as Beaver River Water Commissioner. The motion was seconded and passed.

An assessment of \$10,500.00 was set for water users to pay to meet the 1983 budget. This was passed after a motion by Wayne Wiseman with a second by Sam Hutchings.

It was moved and seconded that the 1982 board be retained. This was agreed upon by vote. The board is as follows:
