The undersigned has been attempting to aid the above identified water company in the efforts undertaken in the past several months with the State Engineer's Office to adjudicate the water in said company as it pertains to surface and underground allocation.

The State Engineer's Office has heretofore received copies of Agreements and reports from the company and from Mr. Clemont Adams, the Water Commissioner. We are advised that Mr. Adams informed the State Engineer's Office that it is important that a decision be made prior to the 1st of April when the pumps will be placed into operation.

We certainly appreciate the fact that there may be some problem created by the unfortunate passing of Mr. Lambert and that the decision may now have to be made by some other representative in the office. However, since it is of critical importance, we would appreciate determining if a temporary Order could not be made pending the appointment of a person to fill the position held by Mr. Lambert. Of course, final Order is desired if possible, and if not, an indication of what arrangements should be made on a temporary basis will be appreciated.
