William Willden, being first duly sworn, deposes and says:

That he is now and has been for more than fifty years last past a resident of the City of Beaver, Sounty of Beaver, State of Utah, where he and his family have lived for more than fifty years last past;


That during the said time he has been acquainted with the 15.2 acres of land referred to in award No. 36 of the decree commonly known as the Beaver River General Adjudication Decree, together with land immediately adjacent to the said premises;

That during the period of about ten or eleven years last past one William R. Yardley has farmed the said premises above referred to and has irrigated the said premises with the water awarded for the irrigation of said premises under said award No. 36;

That he is now and has been during the periods above set forth acquainted with the location where the said William R. Yardley now diverts the water referred to under said award No. 36, for the irrigation of the said 15.2 acres of land, and which point of said diversion is presently at the location of a Parshell flume or steel diverting works in the Greenwood Slough, and is water taken from the water flowing through the South Field Company's ditch which likewise runs through the Greenwood Slough.

That the water so diverted by said William R. Yardley as aforesaid has, to the personal knowledge of this affiant, been taken from the point of diversion set forth in the preceeding paragraph of this affidavit, and which point of diversion has been commonly known as the Greenwood Slough.
