

ASSIGNMENT OF A WATER RIGHT.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, William R. Yardley and Hazel Yardley, his wife, both of the City of Beaver, County of Beaver, State of Utah, parties of the first part and assignors, for and in consideration of the thirty shares of the capital stock of the Second South Field Ditch Company, a Utah irrigation corporation with its principal place of business in Beaver City, Utah, do by these presents sell, transfer and assign to the said Second South Field Ditch Company, party of the second part and assignee, that certain water right more particularly set forth and described in the General Adjudication Decree of the Beaver River, made and entered in the case of W. L. Hardy, et al, plaintiffs, vs Beaver County Irrigation Company, et al., defendants, Edward Bardsley, et al., Intervenors, Case No. 625, in the District Court of Beaver County, Utah, Award No. 28 therein to Juliaette Low, predecessor in interest to these assignors, and which award describes a (a) and (b) water right as follows:

- (a) Priority 1870 25.0 acres - 0.35 c.f.s.
- (b) Priority 1890.25.0 acres - 0.27 c.f.s.

To have and to hold the said water right being hereby assigned with the right of said assignee to apply to the State Engineer of the State of Utah for the right to show a change of ownership of said water right to it, and further to deal with the said water right as the owner thereof in such manner as it may see fit.


