## INTEROFFICE MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT: South Creek Water Commissioner - Monticello

A follow-up meeting to the Blue Mountain Distribution System annual meeting was held Monday, March 29, 1993 in Monticello, to discuss the appointment of a water commissioner for the South Creek portion of the system.

The Water User's Committee for South Creek appointed at the annual meeting had two individuals at this meeting, Mr. Alfredo Garcia and Mr. Ruel Randall. Mr. Garcia will serve as the commissioner, with Mr. Randall as the deputy. They have each agreed to work for \$25.00/day, which will include salary and travel expenses. It is anticipated that they will work from April 1 to May 31, and these gentlemen will be paid on a contractual basis.

The budget that will be assessed would include \$1525.00 for the 61 days. It is felt that a few additional days work may be required, therefore, a budget of \$1800.00 will be assessed. This will be paid according to the following schedule:

1) SJCWCD	60%	\$1080.00
2) Blue Mountain Irr. Co.	10%	\$180.00
3) Gary Halls	10%	\$180.00
4) Monticello City	10%	\$180.00
5) Pioneer Ditch	10%	\$180.00
c/o Monticello City		

It is also the intent of the Conservancy District to use these same gentlemen to operate and monitor Lloyd's Lake. Payment for this service will come directly from the District, under separate arrangements.

A training meeting was held on April 1, 1993 for the commissioner and the deputy. Also, at this time, a staff gage was placed in Dry Wash to be used in conjunction with the V-notch weir that is already in place. A temporary 4-foot rectangular weir will also be placed in Shingle Mill Draw at the Draw's entrance to the reservoir basin. A gage will also be installed for use in conjunction with this weir. When the area dries, parshall flumes will be placed at the Shingle Mill Draw re-diversion point in Pioneer's Ditch and on the Draw, immediately below the rediversion.
