At the request of Chairman Max Dalton, the annual meeting of the Blue Mountain Distribution System was called to order at 7:05 p.m. by Mr. Lee Sim, Assistant State Engineer for Distribution, with the Division of Water Rights.

The first order of business was the reading of the minutes of the 1992 annual meeting. Mark Page read the minutes. There were no corrections or additions to be made. A motion was made by Ernest Sonderegger and seconded by Max Dalton to accept the minutes as read. The vote was unanimous.

The next item of business was a review of the 1992 financial statement. Mr. Lee Sim indicated that as of January 1, 1992, there was \$712.14 in the trust account. Receipts for the year totaled \$22.25, which was interest that accrued to the account. There were no expenditures. Therefore, as of December 31, 1992, there was \$734.39 in the account. A motion was made by Don Barton to accept the financial statement. The motion was seconded by Ernest Sonderegger. The motion passed.

Lee Sim requested that Mark Page read the system summary that was submitted to the Division by Max Dalton. Mr. Dalton indicated that it was the best water year in the past six years for the system, however the water supply was very short. He indicated that water started flowing into Lloyd's Lake during the second week of March, and that the flow diminished to 50-75 gpm during the middle of the summer. North Creek water was put on turns beginning April 30, and irrigation on this system was over by July 1. Gary Halls used water from his North Creek Ditch from April 3 to June 10, and he had approximately three weeks of water on his South Creek Ditch. Verdure Creek produced sufficient water to irrigate until early July, at which time the water supply had diminished appreciably.

A committee was established that would oversee the general Blue Mountain Distribution System, and it will consist of the following people:

A discussion followed concerning the appointment of a water commissioner to distribute the water on the South Creek portion of the system. There would be no assessment made for the commissioner to the North Creek, Verdure Creek, or Spring Creek water users. None of those present had decided on the individual for this position, nor had a budget been determined. Therefore, it

was the consensus of those present that a committee should be formed to find an individual that would accept this position and discuss the financial reimbursement he would receive. Therefore, the following committee was formed to undertake this task:
