BLUE MOUNTAIN DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM

The annual meeting of the Blue Mountain Distribution System was held at the San Juan County Courthouse on March 3, 1982. The meeting began at 7:30 p.m. Max Dalton, Chairman, requested that the meeting be conducted by Mark Page, Area Engineer.

Minutes of last year's meeting were read by Louis Chadwick. The minutes were approved as read.

The next item was the financial statement, -budget and assessments. After a short discussion, it was decided to leave the budget the same as last year and make no assessments.
