Jesse,

I received the following assessment units for Deep Creek water users from Commissioner Bryon Smith via E-mail.

He indicated the following units were delivered, but the actual commissioner reports have not yet been submitted. I've discussed this with Lee and we think it would be best to go ahead and issue these.

Account # 100593 Mosby Irr. ✓ 3944.2 units (However, according to notes this account receives 75% of the total assessment, which would be \$7500)  
Account # 100596 Huber, Martin ✓ 243.8 units  
Account # 100617 Huber, Marvin ✓ 265.7 units  
Account# 100614 Justice, John ✓ 55.5 units  
Account # 103059 Wilkerson, Chad ✓ 19.7 unit's

We would like to send a letter with these assessments explaining the reason they are late. I will draft a letter for Lee to review and sign.

There is one item of concern regarding the assessments. Note all other accounts receive a \$5 minimum. One of the minimum accounts (100604 Circle L Ranch) had a change in ownership and has a balance of over \$200. Circle L Ranch is now "Three Rivers Ranch" and is owned by Robert/Bob Nielson. There is a note on the file that Andrew (Vernal office) might have the new address info. I'm thinking it would be a Lapoint or Roosevelt address and I couldn't find it via the phone books. Feel free to review the file info or research this if you would like to research this further. Otherwise, we can send it to the old address again and do the research later.

I think there are about 11 minimum \$5 assessments to be issued to Deep Creek users who didn't receive water this year.
