Dear Judge Anderson:

I have requested that the State Engineer supply you with the supporting snow pack data ending March 31, 1995 to support [their] claim that the 1995 irrigation season requires a 1995 distribution order due to insufficient water. As you know the months of March and April are the months when the Basin receives the greatest snow pack or rain. The latest snowfall reports indicate we are above average.

You will recall, you made a point indicating to us that unless a need for a distributing order is of evidense, you were not going to make a practice of signing distributuin orders just for the sake of signing.....

I am enclosing the record of Duchesne/Strawberry water users, and the Acre feet diverted. I have cause to wonder where the CUP got from this drainage area 44,713 Ac Ft of water. They sure didnt buy any water from me, however I will be losing 38 ac feet if I do not protest, and possibly more. 44,713 is a lot of water, especially when there is such a thing as water being cut by a priority date, which the court makes invalid through the signing of a distribution order. As I told the court before we cannot allow our neighbors to go with out water here in the basin. Yet our ranchers are forced to send their livestock to Wyoming and Colorado because they cannot obtain the water they need to grow pasture here. This is not reasonable.

The Bear River drainage can supply water to the Wasatch front. Millions of Gallons flow into the Great Salt Lake annually. "SIC" you must have read that the State Of Utah is attempting to sell water out of State to Nevada. Does this sound like insufficient water? I encourage the court to exercise sound judgement at this time in history regarding the water contained in the Uintah Basin. Naturally I object to the court signing a 1995 Distribution order, absent the official water survey records for 1995. I was present when we Basin residents were promised, that we came first, and we would have water for Leland Bench, Blue Bench, thousands of acres of barren land here would blossom and flourish.
