

**MINUTES OF THE DEEP CREEK DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM ANNUAL MEETING**  
**DAVE MURRAY'S SHOP, LA POINT, UTAH**  
**January 30, 2001**

Minutes of the Deep Creek Distribution System held at La Point, Utah, January 30, 2001. The meeting convened at 11:40 a.m. with Wayne Justice conducting.

Mr. Justice brought the meeting to order. Minutes of the previous year's meeting were read by John Larsen of the Salt Lake Water Rights Office. There were no corrections to be made to the minutes so a motion was then made by Charmin Justice to approve them, seconded by Aaron Simmons. Motion passed.

Lee Sim read the financial report, budget expenditures, and delinquent water assessments for 2000. The balance of the distribution funds at the beginning of the year was \$4,849.01, receipts were \$6,543.10, expenditures at \$6,358.69, leaving a balance at the end of the year \$5,033.42. Only one account was outstanding in the name of David Murray. The \$1,000.00 for contractual services was used by Charmin to improve the Robert & Irvin Young diversion. A motion was made by John Allred and seconded by Elmer Ekins to accept the financial report as given. Motion carried.

River Commissioner Charman Justice then gave her report on the activities on the river for 2000. She mentioned there was very little water from Deep Creek in April but flows improved greatly during the month of May due to rainfall. The Mosby water supply was distributed based upon the 12.0 cfs and 15.0 cfs duty. Mosby water supply never did reach the 30.0 cfs duty the entire irrigation season. During September, water supply from Blanchett Park was shut down so work could proceed on the pipeline. Charmin mentioned the Deep Creek users called for meeting in November to discuss bringing the upper Deep Creek users into the distribution system. Consensus of the four individuals who showed up to the meeting was they did not want to join the system.

A motion was then made by Raymond Murray to accept the report as given, seconded by John Allred, all approved.

The water users then discussed the budget for 2001. A motion was made by Marvin Huber to have the budget remain at \$8,231.00 and the assessment at \$5,900.00, the same as year 2000. A second was made by John Allred, all approved.

Mr. Sim entertained a motion by both the Mosby and Deep Creek users to select a commissioner for the 2001 irrigation season. The Mosby water users in previous meeting had nominated Bryan Smith as commissioner for the next four years. The voting was 5 for, 2 against. A motion was then made by Charmin Justice of the Deep Creek users to accept Bryan Smith as commissioner, seconded by Martin Huber, all Deep Creek users approved. Motion carried.

Directors were then discussed for this system. A motion was made by Charmin Justice to retain Wayne Justice as chairman of the board and John Allred as board member. The motion was seconded by Marvin Huber, the voting was unanimous.

With no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 11:55 a.m.
