Motion to accept the minutes by Earl Wright, seconded by Lynn Baadsgaard. Motion carried.

Lee Sim, Division of Water Rights, went over the expenditures for the year 1988, which can be found in the Commissioner's Report for the year 1988.

At this time there was a discussion of the delinquent accounts and the collection of such.

Motion to accept expenditures by Loryn S. Ross, seconded by Joe Clayburn. Motion carried.

David K. Clayburn, River Commissioner, presented his report for the year 1988.

Motion by Loryn Ross that David K. Clayburn, be commended for his fine work as River Commissioner for the past 14 years. Seconded by Daniel Dennis. Motion unanimous

Motion by Leo L. Brady to accept commissioners report. Seconded by Joe Curry. Motion carried.

Question raised on retirement for commissioner, Lee Sim to look into 401 K. or some other form of retirement.

Motion by George Lindsay that John Swasey be appointed the River Commissioner for year 1989, seconded by Sonny Van. Motion carried.

Discussion of budget for coming year.

Motion by Loryn Ross to leave the budget of \$22,482.00 as is, seconded by Leland Wright. Motion carried.

Motion by Loryn Ross, to leave to the Board to negotiate with river commissioner concerning retirement when more information is available. Seconded by Lynn Baasgaard, Motion carried.

Guy Taylor made a motion that the total budget of \$22,882. be assessed to water users, seconded by Sonny Van. Motion carried.

Nominations open for two board positions, the names of Art Taylor and Clinton Moon nominated by group. Motion by Bill Williams, seconded by Joe Clayburn to put them in by acclamation. Motion carried.

Report by Keith R Hooper, Central Utah Water Conservancy District, on contents at Starvation Reservoir and current snow report.

Loryn Ross brought up the issue of the salt content in Starvation Reservoir rising and ask the State Engineer to check into this.

At this time, Craig Thomas was asked to present his groups proposal for the benefit of those from the State Engineers office. Also Loryn Ross presented his proposal for consideration by the State Engineers office.

Lee Sim said that he will take back these proposals and discuss them with Robert L. Morgan, State Engineer, with the middle of March as a mailing of the decision.
