
Dear Judge Harding:

Pursuant to our telephone conversation yesterday I am enclosing herewith a Motion and proposed Order in the above-entitled matter. As noted in the Motion, the proposal for a 3.5 acre-foot duty schedule on the Duchesne River System for the 1978 irrigation season was previously transmitted to all counsel and, while we have received no formal objections (other than from Mr. Jim Lee, representing the Uinta Basin Irrigation Company), there may well be others who will want to register their views now that a Hearing is to be held on this matter on August 9th.

The documents enclosed are being transmitted to counsel, along with a copy of this letter. If anyone has serious objection to this procedure, I assume they will contact you immediately. Otherwise, if you find the documents to be in order, I would appreciate your executing the proposed Order and transmitting both of these documents to the Duchesne County Clerk for filing. A stamped, addressed envelope is enclosed herewith for this purpose. Also, I am enclosing xerox copies of these documents for your file since the Clerk's file will not be available to you at the August 9th Hearing.
