The submission of briefs on the Indian water right question has been delayed while the parties make a further effort to resolve this problem by agreement. The Governor has agreed to act as chairman for the initial meeting which will probably take place in about ten days. However, in order to have some basis for distribution for the coming year I asked Judge Harding to set a date to review this matter. He has set a hearing in the governor's board room on March 6, 1973 at 10:00 a.m. for this purpose.

I have also received a letter from John Boyden indicating that the Indians will want 4 ac.-ft. this year. A copy of that letter is enclosed for your information. Some time within the next couple of weeks we should get together and decide what the State Engineer intends to recommend as far as a distribution program for the 1973 irrigation season.
