Minutes of the 1990 Deep Creek Distribution meeting were read by Bob Leake. Charman Justice made a motion to accept the minutes as read and Raymond Murray seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Lance Luck proposed that Mosby apply to change period of use. Raymond Murray stated that he would protest. Dave Murray made a motion to table the discussion until something is done by Mosby Irrigation. Seconded by?

Motion was made by Raymond Murray that Deep Creek repair Mill Canyon weir and
seconded by Wayne Justice. Motion carried.

Lance Luck made a motion that the Commissioner's Report be accepted and motion
was seconded by Wayne Justice. Motion passed.

Prepare budget - changes - on pay procedures, now need to pay social security,
w.c., disability, bond now \$100.

Raymond motioned to have budget assessment same (\$6400) - with the increases
needed for the above and travel raised to \$1800. Wayne Justice seconded and
motion carried.
