

1990 DEEP CREEK DISTRIBUTION MEETING

The 1990 Annual Deep Creek Distribution Meeting was convened at 10:07 a.m. on February 14, 1990 and was conducted by Lee Sim of the State of Utah Division of Water Rights.

Minutes of the 1989 Deep Creek Distribution meeting were read by Bob Leake. Charman Justice made a motion to accept the minutes and Raymond Murray seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Lee Sim presented the 1989 Financial Report. It was noted that some of the expenses listed in the report were actually 1988 expenses that were not charged to the 1988 fiscal year. Raymond Murray made a motion to accept the financial report and Robert Justice seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Charman Justice presented the 1989 Commissioner's Report. A discussion ensued concerning the period of irrigation for the water rights of the Mosby Irrigation Company. Charman believes that the first date that the company can take water for irrigation is May 1 rather than April 1. It was pointed out by Dave Murray representing Mosby Irrigation that there is a water right that the company owns that is located at Logger's Cabin. There was a discussion about whether this is in the Dry Fork drainage or the Deep Creek drainage. The discussion was not settled. Bob Leake said that he would look into the problem. The need for an updated priority schedule was discussed. Lee Sim said that Water Rights would prepare a priority schedule before April 1. Raymond Murray made a motion to accept the Commissioner's Report and Aaron Simmons seconded the motion. The motion carried.

The 1990 budget was then discussed. Robert Justice made a motion to raise the contractual services to \$3,500. However, there was no second and the motion died. Raymond Murray made a motion to leave the budget the same (\$6,400) and raise the assessments to \$6,400. Charman Justice seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Charman Justice stated that Larry McKee needs to put a wheel on his headgate, that the weir at Mill Canyon needs to be fixed, and that A. C. Wilkerson's headgate needs some repairs. She also stated that Mosby needs to work out their turn schedule.

The discussion turned to the appointment of a River Commissioner. Robert Justice made a motion to retain Charman Justice and Dave Murray seconded the motion. The motion carried.

The nomination of Directors for the Deep Creek Distribution System was discussed. Charman Justice made a motion to retain the current Directors (Raymond Murray, Wayne Justice, and Martin Huber). The motion was seconded by Aaron Simmons and the motion carried.
