MINUTES
DEEP CREEK DISTRIBUTION MEETING
MARCH 8, 1983

Don Norseth, acting as Chairman, opened the meeting at 9:45 a.m. and gave a rundown on water conditions around the state. Conditions are very unusual and the state should have a good water year with a chance of flooding in some areas. The Wasatch front is experiencing flooding at the present time. Mosby Mountain is 148% of normal.

Bob Guy read the minutes of the 1982 meeting. Arben Wilkerson moved to accept the minutes as read, and seconded by Raymond Murray. The motion carried.

Don Norseth read the financial statement. It was moved by Aaron Simmons and seconded by Arben Wilkerson that the financial statement be accepted as read. Motion carried.

Dick Perry gave his commissioners report. He stated tha overall 1982 was a good water year. He also mentioned that a weir is needed on Mosby Creek at the confluence and that the headgates of Arben Wilkerson, Lanny Cook and Darvel Cook need repairing. Bob was requested to check the water rights of Lynn Martinsen. → *JUSTICE*

The 1983 budget was then discussed. The 1983 budget was set at \$5,540.00 of which \$750 would be for the purchase and installation of a weir in Mosby Creek. The assessment was set at \$5200.00. It was moved by Raymond Murray and seconded by Arben Wilkerson that the budget and assessment be approved. Motion carried.

It was moved by Raymond Murray and seconded by Arben Wilkerson that last year's executive committee be put in by acclamation for the year 1983. Motion carried. Committee members are: Aaron Simmons, Marvin Huber and Raymond Murray.

The group recommended Dick Perry for water commissioner.
