

DEEP CREEK WATER USER'S MEETING

March 17, 1972

Don Norseth opened the meeting at 10:15 a.m. and read the minutes of last years meeting. The minutes were approved as read.

Don then read the financial statement which was approved as read.

The water commissioner, Adrian Kump, was not present and had not submitted his report todate.

The group felt that Adrian had done a pretty good job last year and recommended him as commissioner for 1972.

After some discussion the 1972 budget was set at \$1,820.94 and the assessment at \$1,800.00.

There was a discussion on the Mosby Canal. It was indicated that the measuring device at Julius Park would be used rather than the one at Blanchet Park as Mosby gets the make in the canal between Blanchet and Julius.

Dorothy Luck asked why the Mosby Irrigation Co. could not claim and reuse the water the company put in the Deep Creek system. Don explained that once the water reached the natural channel it became part of the system and was subject to appropriation.

There was some discussion on the distribution procedure and Bob Guy was requested to contact the Commissioner and make sure that he is following the distribution procedure.

Orlando Cook asked about the distribution of Flash Flood waters. Bob Guy was instructed to contact the Commissioner and see if a program could be worked out to distribute these waters.

There was discussion on the Indian right out of West Mosby and it was noted that this right was to be measured at Loggers cabin.

Don Norseth mentioned that the assessment for 1972 would be based on last years acre foot delivery if there was enough information in the Commissioners report.

Meeting adjourned at 11:30 a.m.

The Deep Creek Water User's Committee was brought up. It was moved that the committee stay the same: O. J. Cook, Marvin Huber, David Jenkins. This was seconded and carried with no opposed.
