Dear Mr. Buckley:

It has come to our attention that you are using some points of diversion which do not correspond to existing water rights.

According to State Water Law (Utah Code 73-3-3), it is unlawful for any person to change or attempt to change a point of diversion, place, or purpose of use, either permanently or temporarily, without first applying to the State Engineer.

If you do intend to continue using these points of diversion, then you must file a Change Application(s) with this office. If a change application (s) has not been filed with this office by next irrigation season, water will not be delivered at the unauthorized points of diversion.

Also, it appears that title work on these water rights needs to be updated.

Please contact our office at your earliest convenience so we can resolve this matter.
