the Board of Directors of the Duchesne-Strawberry Rivers Water Users Association met at 10:30 a.m., March 4, 1982, in the Duchesne County Court House, Duchesne.

President Ray Thomas, presiding with Board Members, William R. Peatross, Earl N. Wright, Earvin Murphy, Maurice E. Harvey, Loryn S. Ross, Water Commissioner David K. Clayburn, Representatives of the Bureau of Indian Affairs and Secretary C. C. Mickelson were present.

Moved by Mr. Murphy 2nd Mr. Wright the meeting of the Board of Directors held March 6, 1981, be approved. Motion carried.

President Ray Thomas reported the money certificate No. 100-0899404, as of April 1, 1980, is \$1529.28. This certificate is in the First Security Bank of Utah, Duchesne, Utah.

It was Moved by Mr. Wright Seconded by Mr. Harvey, the Board of Directors approve the appointment of David K. Clayburn as Water Commissioner for year 1982. The salary to be \$10,000.00 per year and 40¢ per mile for use of car. (the same as the previous year). Motion carried.

The Water Users are to pay 50% of the Commissioners Health Program or about \$650.00 per year.

Board Members Earl Wright, Loryn S. Ross and William Peatross' Term will expire in the year 1982. Members will need to be elected at the annual meeting at 11:00 a.m.
