

Huntington Creek Distribution System
Annual Water Users Meeting
February 3, 1987

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The annual meeting of the Huntington Creek Distribution System was convened at 10:30 a.m. by Chairman, Hal Guymon. He asked Commissioner Mar Grange to read the minutes of the 1986 annual meeting. Eugene Johansen moved that the minutes be accepted as read. Bill Guymon seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous.

A brief discussion followed concerning the present snow pack data and the anticipated water supply for the upcoming irrigation season. According to the SCS Snotel data dated January 26 1987, Red Pine Ridge was at 42% of average water content. As of January 1, 1987, the projected stream flow for Huntington Creek for the period of April through July is estimated at 40,000 AF or 73% of normal. It is anticipated that all of the reservoirs will fill, so there should not be any shortage of water. However, there probably will not be a long high water period this year. At the present time, Electric Lake has about 25,000 acre feet of water in storage.

The next item of business was the reading of the 1986 financial statement. As of December 31, 1986, the balance of funds in the trust account was \$5031.37. Total receipts during the year were \$11,348.17 with \$11,075.48 being expended. An over expenditure of \$25.48 was made to the commissioner for travel expenses for October. A motion was made by Carly Burton to accept the financial statement as read. Eugene Johansen seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Bill Guymon made a motion to set the budget for 1987 at the same figure as in 1986. This would set the budget at \$11,200.00 and an assessment of \$11,000.00. The motion was seconded by Carly Burton. The motion passed. Therefore, the 1987 budget is as follows:

Chairman Guymon stated that the next item of business was the appointment of a river commissioner for the 1987 water year. Carly Burton made a motion to reappoint Mr. Mar Grange for another year of service. Bill Guymon made a second to this motion. All present were in favor.

Mr. Grange then made a brief statement concerning his report and the 1987 water year. There was plenty of water last year for all users. The boils on Millers Flat Reservoir were remedied with the replacement of the outlet line on the cutoff drain. It is anticipated that no water will be stored this coming year in Huntington Reservoir. Plans are being made to enlarge this reservoir during 1987. It is planned to let bids on the job in April and start construction in June. At the present time, water running through the Huntington Reservoir basin is flowing into the Cleveland Reservoir feeder ditch, so the water is not being wasted.

The next item of business was the appointment of a committee. Bill Guymon made a motion to retain the same group who served in 1986. Carly Burton made a second to the motion. The vote was unanimous. Therefore, the following committee was seated:
