Re: Little Bear River Dist. Sys.

This letter is in response to your inquiry concerning your 1992 assessment.

The assessments are based on the previous years water use. In 1990 you used 76.91 acre-feet out of a total of 38,040.15 acre-feet delivered on the system or 20%. In 1991, you were delivered 76.90 out of a total of 34,204.46 acre-feet delivered on the system or 22%. Your 1992 assessment was calculated by multiplying the total system assessment (\$4100) by your percentage of the water delivered total. The amount shown on your assessment notice is your correct proportionate share of the 1992 assessment.

The distribution system is regulated by the State Engineer under authority of Section 73-5-1, Utah Code Annotated, 1953, as amended to insure orderly distribution of water based on water rights. A budget is set and assessments are made each year to meet the expenses of the distribution system including the commissioner's salary. The budget and assessments are set by the water users at the annual distribution meeting with the State Engineer. If assessments are not paid by June 1st, a delinquent penalty of 10% is added.
