RE: 2003 Huntington Creek River Commissioner Report


Dear Mark,

We have reviewed the 2003 Huntington Creek River Commission Report and would like to address several items we consider to be lacking in the report:

1. There is no summary report included on the diversions from the river.
2. There was no mention in the report of the 773 Ac. Ft. of water that was short in the Huntington North Reservoir as of March 1, 2003, or what water was used to finish filling it.
3. There was no mention of project water in the CC&H Canal or the Huntington North Reservoir. These items need to be included.
4. There was no mention of the 2,000 Ac. Ft. of water that was traded by Utah Power to the Joes Valley Reservoir.
5. There was nothing said of the 1,232 Ac. Ft. of water that Utah Power sent from Joes Valley Reservoir to the canals of the Huntington-Cleveland Irrigation Company.
6. There was nothing said in the report concerning the four Huntington-Cleveland Reservoirs. How much water ran into them? How much ran out? How much water was in Electric Lake? How much was not accounted for?
7. No mention was made of how much water was pumped out of James Canyon 1 and James Canyon 2 wells?
8. The report made no mention of the special leasing of water by Utah Power from the Huntington-Cleveland Irrigation Company stockholders.
9. There was no accounting of the water that was pumped from Huntington Creek and used on the Utah Power Research Farm.

It is the opinion of the Emery Water Conservancy District that the 2003 Huntington Creek River Commissioner Report is not complete and the above mentioned information must be included to make the document more complete and credible.
