

A meeting of the Executive Committee of the Duchesne River water-users was held in the Sheriff's office, Duchesne, Utah, on July 29. The meeting was called at 1:30 and all members were present with the exception of Emil Munz. Mr. Munz came to the meeting later and upon being advised of the actions taken by the committee prior to his arrival, approved all of the motions.

The meeting was opened by a short discussion of delinquents and at the request of the chairman, Mr. Colton read the delinquents for 1934. Mr. Defa made the motion that water be shut off from all 1934 delinquents on August 10, unless assessments were paid prior to that time. This motion was seconded and passed unanimously.


Horace Allred made a motion that no assessments be made against the Moon Lake Water-Users' Association for 1935, owing to the fact that the association would not draw water during the year 1935. This motion was seconded by Mr. Defa and carried unanimously.

After considerable discussion relative to delinquents for the first half of the period 1935, Mr. Lott made the motion that notices be sent to all appropriators who have not paid one-half of the 1935 assessment; that the committee has instructed the water commissioner to follow the orders of the State Engineer, and to close down immediately all canals of the appropriators who have not yet paid the first half of the 1935 assessments. This motion was seconded by Mr. Defa, and carried unanimously.

Upon a report by Mr. Colton, it was found that in all probability one-half of the assessment will be all that will be required to pay the entire expense for 1935. It was the opinion of some of the members that the committee should cancel the second half of the assessment for 1935 but it was decided to wait a short time before this action be taken as some unforeseen conditon or event might require a little additional money which would necessitate calling for a little more than one half of the assessment.

According to actions taken by the general water-users' meeting this spring, all members of the committee were to receive \$3.00 per day and 5¢ per mile for attendance at the meetings. Following are the amounts due the committee members for this meeting:
