2 bodies found frozen near Jordan River

SOUTH SALT LAKE -- Two bodies were found frozen Thursday morning near the Jordan River near 2700 South.

South Salt Lake Police officer say the two were huddled together on the bank of the river.

They believe they are homeless.

One was identified as a man, but officers have not said anything about the other person.

"It's been very cold over the night and tight now it's even a whole lot colder than it appears to be. Snow, cold weather, high winds last night. That probably contributed to it," said Gary Keller of the South Salt Lake Police Dept.

The low temperature overnight was 30 degrees.

This area is near the Oxbow jail and a transient camp along the Jordan River.

They were found by a passerby.

Police say there are no signs of foul play.
