Dear Thomas Ward:

I received some of the flow data I asked for at our last Creek committee meeting of January 2005. Would you forward to me the daily CFS values for the LittleCottonwood Creek for the entire year of 2004.

For the irrigation season of 2004, you show we used 1463 acre feet from the Creek at the head and 658 acre feet of canal water. In my letter of August 17, 2004, I commented how the readings just did not seem correct for the usage from the canal. We got together and tried to sort it out. I noticed the data still did not seem quite right after my letter and the meeting we had. This last irrigation season was unusual since we started using all our water from the creek about the last month of the season. If I look at our total use one September 11, 2204 when were using canal water, and it was being measured especially on the East Branch where I say it was not being measured accurately, it was 4.05 CFS. Toward the end of September when our water was coming out of the Creek, it was around 7 CFS. There is about 3 CFS difference. I think there is a problem with the accuracy of the measurement of the canal water in our East Branch and the Barret Branch. We need to address this problem before this next irrigation season.
