Murray City Power Department has been going through a period of significant change which has affected the working responsibilities of many of our employees. As you know, I have been serving as Acting General Manager since last February. It was in that capacity that I attended the May 6, 1998 meeting of the Little Cottonwood Creek Distribution System Committee.

On June 10, 1998, Mayor Dan Snarr announced to the Department my appointment as General Manager. The City Council will confirm the appointment in their June 30, 1998 City Council meeting. With this change, I have asked Brian Smith, Plants and Substations supervisor, to serve as the new Murray City representative on the Committee.
