Annual Meeting of Water Users of the Logan River System and  
Representatives of the State Engineer's Office

— January 22, 1986

Kent Jones called the meeting to order by welcoming those present and introducing himself, Bob Fotheringham, Northern Area Engineer and Bob Leake from the Logan Staff.

Mr. Jones read the minutes of the last meeting upon request of Lyle Beck. A motion was made by Reed Johnson to accept the minutes as read. Seconded by Serge Bodrero. Motion passed.

Mr. Jones read the 1985 Financial Statement indicating a balance of trust funds on hand as of January 1, 1986 of \$4,652.20. Regular assessments during the year amounted to \$7,263.20 with expenditures of ~~\$8,011.38~~ <sup>\$7,731.38</sup> leaving a balance of trust funds, as of December 31, 1985 of \$4,196.36. He asked about the delinquent payments and it was stated that Account #16 should be shown as paid. The interest earned statement and rest of financial statement needed explanation. Also, a follow up on the Darrell Kunzler account needed to be done. A motion was made to approve the financial statement as amended. Seconded by Blaine Morris. Motion passed.

Terry Gnehm was asked to explain the recorder purchase by users, at the request of Lyle Beck. Budget items were then discussed. It was decided that a daily log must be kept by the commissioner on time spent on system. Reid Johnson commented that Terry took care of the water in a fine <sup>manor</sup> ~~manor~~ and did a good job. Lyle Beck stated that a good man is worth more. There was discussion about the condition of the equipment and the need. Rod Blossom, representing Logan City, felt that equipment should continue to be replaced as needed. With a considerable amount of discussion, it was approved by the body to have Lyle Beck authorize other expenditures, such as the need for additional recorders, etc. A motion was made by Lamon Perkes to assess a budget of \$6,000 plus taking \$651.00 from the reserves. Seconded by Wayne Cardon. Motion passed. A separate motion was made by Reid Johnson to accept a new budget of \$6,651.00 total for the year of 1986. Seconded by Floyd Isrealson. Motion passed.
