



MINUTES

of the

Annual Meeting of Water Users of the Logan River System and  
Representatives of the State Engineer's Office

January 16, 1985

Richard B. Hall called the meeting to order by welcoming those present and introducing Jerry Bronicel from the Salt Lake Distribution Office, Bob Fotheringham, acting Logan Area Engineer, and John P. Jensen from the Logan Staff.

Mr. Hall stated that Clinton Crockett would not be at the meeting and there would be no minutes read as Merlin King was not present either.

Mr. Hall read the 1984 Financial Statement indicating the balance of trust funds on hand as of January 1, 1984 of \$ 5,063.71. Regular assessments during the year amounted to \$ 6,333.46 with expenditures of \$ 6,760.82, leaving a balance of trust funds, as of December 31, 1984, of \$ 4,652.20. He asked about the delinquent assessments.

Mr. Hall asked who the president of the Logan River Water Users Association was; Don Hansen replied that it was Lyle Beck and Merlin King was the secretary. At this time Richard Hall asked approval to invest the trust funds to make interest on the balance. Don Hansen made a motion to do that, Reid Johnson seconded, and it was approved by the body.

There was alot of discussion regarding Clinton Crockett as last years commissioner, and that it was not a good experience. At this time Terry Gnehm stated that he would like to take the job as the new commissioner. Don Hansen recommended that the Logan River Water Users Association hire Terry Gnehm and explained his feeling about Terry's qualifications. A motion was made by Don Hansen, seconded by Reid Johnson and approved by the body that Terry Gnehm be the new commissioner.

LaMon Perkes had a question regarding the limit of \$ 700.00 for the number of miles that Clinton Crockett drove. Because there were no minutes of last years meeting, it was not known if there was a limit. At this time Richard Hall made a line by line review of the budget for next year. There was some discussion about the need for new recorders, and repairs of measuring devises needed on the river. Also it was requested that a count be made of the good measuring devises and number of good clocks that they presently have. A decision was made to purchase two new recorders. A motion was made by Lamom Perkes that they accept the total budget as presented, it was seconded by Reid Johnson. Also a motion was made by Val Peterson to assess \$ 7,000 for the budget, it was seconded by Lamom Perkes, both motions were approved by the body.

At this time a discussion insued about Logan City's payment for water use. It was stated that the State Engineer said he would write a Memorandum of Understanding upon the request of Val Peterson to resolve the conflict.

Those in attendance to the meeting expressed a desire to have a copy of the Annual Report of the Logan River Distribution System for the year of 1984 sent to them when it was received by the State Engineer.

With no other business, the meeting was adjourned.
