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WATER RIGHTS

Minutes of the Annual Meeting of Logan River Water Users and Representatives from State of Utah Dept. of Natural Resources Water Rights.

Meeting was called to order at 11.10 A M January 17, 1984. Meeting was held in the Chamber of Commerce Building with Michael Turnipseed acting as chairman in the absence of Steve Olsen. The Minutes of the meeting held January 1983 were read. LaMon Perkes made a motion to accept the minutes as read, motion was seconded by Terry Gnehm and all present voted in favor.

The Financial Statement for 1984 was presented to the members present.

Michael Turnipseed reported that the money for the recorder had not as yet been spent but the recorder was ordered and this money would be spent for the recorder. Terry Gnehm made a motion that we accept the financial report as presented. LaMon Perkes seconded the motion and all present voted in favor.

Fern Nate made the commissioners report on the 1983 irrigation season. She stated that the available water for the 1983 irrigation season was very plentiful. She stated that it was the first year for many years that it was not necessary to go into regulation. Logan River peaked on May 30th at 1,432 cfs and never did recede below 250 cfs for the remainder of the summer. Fern and Stan Nate said that they were going to retire and thanked all the people concerned with water use for their cooperation and help they received as water commissioners.

Michael Turnipseed introduced Walter Scott who is interested in the job as Water Commissioner. He would like to take the job on a contract basis for \$6,000.00. Don Hansen said that Glen Downs was also interested in the job. After some discussion it was decided not to hire a commissioner at this time but to have a meeting in the Engineer's Office February 7th, at 10.00 A. M. to further discuss this matter.

A budget was set up for the 1984 season. The budget is as follows.

Other business brought up was that Logan City requested that the Commissioner read the meter at Mendon bridge on Logan River. Officers are needed for the organization. Steve Olsen chairman has moved. This will be accomplished at a later date.

A resolution was passed thanking the retiring commissioners for eight years of service to the Logan River Water Users for their dedicated service to their job as commissioners and for a job well done.
