

Minutes of the Annual Meeting of Water Users of the Logan River system and representatives of the State Engineers Office.

The annual Meeting of the Logan River Water User's Association and the State Division of Water Rights was held in the Mtn. Fuel Supply building February 9th 1976 at 11.00 A. M.

The purpose of the meeting was to hear the minutes of last years meeting, the financial report from the controller's office, and to set up a budget and appoint a Water Commissioner for the coming year.

Don Norseth of the State Engineers Office opened the meeting at 11.05 AM. Mr Norseth said the water year does not look to good at the present time. He made a report on some of the watersheds state wide, most reservoirs are full or above normal. Forecast on Logan River was 100% of average over the last 15 years. February 1st report 80 to 100% of normal.

Mr. Alfred Gnehm read the call to meeting and stated the purpose of the meeting. The financial report was presented. Val Peterspn made a motion to accept the financial report seconded by Maholn Rice and all present voted in favor. Mike Turnipseed reported that there were no delinquent assessments at the present time and a balance of \$2001.59 was on hand at the present time. Heber Olsen made a motion to accept the minutes as read seconded by Owen Jensen and all present voted in favor.

Bud Robison reported on the irrigation year in 1975 stating that it was a very good water year. Mr. Robison asked for a increase of \$200.00 for the 1976 water year. He also asked for 15cents a mile for mileage on job, and if gas raisen 10cents a gallon another cent increase in the mileage rate. He also asked for four days holiday over the memorial day weekend, stating he would have someone take care of his duties while he was away. There was some opposition to a raise in salary and asked if the job justified an increase in salary. Bud suggested there was a 10% increase in inflation. Mr. Norseth said it takes more time to do the job. Some question on the time spent and the mileage increase. Mayor Anderson of Logan City paid a compliment to the people who are involved in the irrigation companies on their diligence in performing their duties. Heber Olsen made a motion that the raise in salary be granted, seconded by Terry Gnehm the motion carried.

A Budget was presented for 1976 totaling 3541.00 and was accepted by those present. Mike Turnipseed new office is located at 55 E. 1st N. in logan.

Some disussion was held about the river washing property away from the banks in high water time. It was stated that it would quite hard to make the Logan River water Users responsible for this as long as they have done nothing to alter the stream flow.
