Minutes of Meeting

A meeting with the State Engineer's Office and the Logan River Water Users Ass'n was held at the Oldham Memorial Building at 1:30 P.M. on Jan. 18, 1966.

Donald Norseth opened the meeting and introduced the member from the Engineers Office.

Pres. Gnehm asked that the minutes of last years meeting be read.

Lyman Johnson read the minutes of the meeting, and Frank Reese read the financial report. Both were approved by all present. A delinquent account no. 25 for the years 64 and 65 H.R. Weston and Sons % Roscoe Weston % Donald McEntire to be taken care of through the State Engineers Office.

Pres. Gnehm talked about some trouble caused by someone raising and lowering the headgates and that the water commissioner only should do this being appointed by the State Engineers Office.

Ray Theurer had a complaint of too much water in the waste ditch that runs through his fields causing flooding and that someone should help out.

P.H. Schultz talked about the help the Forest Service had rendered in the past and would do so in the future if they were contacted.

J.W. Quayle made a motion that the budget be set up the same as 1965 of \$2500.00. Seconded by Reed Johnson and passed by all present.

This report is to be mailed to all water companies as soon as possible.


