A meeting of the State Engineer's Office and the Logan River Water Users Ass'n. was held at the Oldham Memorial Building. Meeting starting at 9:40 A.M.

The purpose of the meeting was to hear a financial report of the Logan River water distribution system, set up a budget for the coming year, and to appoint a water commissioner.

Mr. Wayne Criddle, State Engineer, introduced the other members of the State Engineer's Office.

President of the Logan River Water Users Ass'n., Alfred H. Gnehm, asked for the minutes. Lyman H. Johnson Sec. of the Logan River Water Users Ass'n. read the minutes and they were approved by all present.

Mr. Frank Reese read the financial report and stated that all but \$9,57 of last years assesments had been paid and that \$1.00 would be charged for each \$10.00 of delinquent payments. This report was also approved by all present.

President Alfred H. Gnehm asked Frank Haws to make a report. Mr. Haws asked that a new staff gauge be installed at the "Y". Also that Logan City used about \$3,200.00 of Logan River Water Users water, and that no water was delivered by Logan City. When his report for the year was printed all the reports would be in it and that it would be sent to all the irrigation companies.

President Gnehm stated that the water commissioners salary was too high and that some of the presidents of the companies also thought so. A motion was made by J.G. Plowman that a budget be made for the coming year as follows:

Seconded by J.W. Quayle. Passed by a vote of 10 to 3.

President Gnehm asked Frank Haws if he would take the commissioners job at this salary which was about the same as in 1963.

Mr. Haws said that for the work he was doing the salary for the past year was too low and that this was too much of a cut to take.

A motion was made by J.W. Quayle that the assessment to the Logan River Water Users be \$2,500.00 for 1965. Seconded by J.G. Plowman.

This was followed by a long talk by Mr. Donald Norseth that stated that the water users were being cheap, considering the good work Mr. Haws had been doing for the water users, and in the reports he was asked to work on in keeping records. Mr. Norseth also stated that the directors should find a new commissioner and present him for approval in the near future.

A motion was made by Alfred H. Gnehm that the meeting close. Seconded by Serge Bodrero. Meeting adjourned.
