The meeting was held on January 22, 1992, at 2:30 p.m. in Loa, Utah. Lee Sim called the meeting to order. Kirk Forbush read the minutes from the 1991 meeting. The motion was made by Phillip Pace and seconded by Keith Durfey to accept the minutes as read. Motion carried. Lee Sim read the financial report. It was noted that there was no delinquent accounts. A motion was made by Don Torgorson and seconded by Phillip Pace to accept the financial report as read. Motion carried.

Commissioner Bobby Edwards gave his report. He stated that the systems was in good condition. Last years water deliveries were good. The "B" water was not cut back until June 26. The rains that occurred during the summer helped the water delivered a lot. Bobby stated that the changes that were occurring in the system were mostly sprinkler systems that were being put in. Phillip pace asked how the water was going to be measured to the Alexander Farm now that they are installing gated pipe and a sprinkler system. Bobby stated that the headgates servicing the gated pipe would need to be rated. Kirk Forbush stated that he would assist in rating these headgates this spring. Bobby stated that he would measure the water in the Alexanders' sprinkler system based upon the number of sprinkler heads that they are running. Lee Sim said that this would be acceptable if Bobby had an accurate value for the operating pressure and orifice size. Keith Durfey made a motion to accept the commissioners report. Kathy Bagley seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Lee Sim then reviewed the proposed 1992 budget. Bobby Edwards pointed out that his salary for 1991 was \$2000.00 and that the additional \$258.00 was his retirement money added on. Phillip Pace made a motion and Keith Durfey seconded the motion that the commissioners salary be increased by \$100.00 per year. Motion carried. The 1992 budget was set at \$5100.00 and it was proposed to set the 1992 assessment at \$4500.00. Phillip Pace made a motion to accept the 1992 budget as outlined. Val Bowles seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Don Torgorson made the motion to nominate Bobby Edwards as river commissioner for 1992. Val Bowles seconded the motion. Motion carried.
