Dear Mayor Larson:

On Wednesday, July 15, 1992, I met with Ben Kjar to review with him the distribution of Manti City Creek. Mr. Kjar's primary concern was with the regulation of water diverted for power. If the distribution is not coordinated with the Manti City Creek Water Users, at certain times, too much water is going to the farms and too little to the town users or visa versa.

After review of the distribution of Manti City Creek and the water right appurtenant to the various uses for each water company, I would like to suggest that Manti City work with Manti City Creek Water Users in properly distributing water in Manti Creek.

Proper regulation of this water is important due to the location of the power plant discharge.
