Gunnison Fayette vs Gunnison Court Case 1968-69

25 CFS ahead or any rights Highland has on San Pitch, 6 mile, 12 Mile

The 15 CFS after Highland filled

Highland Rights" 1986 Priority, 85.62 CFS / 40 CFS

From San Pitch below Gunnison reservoir

6 mile At confluence w/ Pettyville Canal

12 Mile at confluence w/ Highland Canal

Current Gunnison Position = Water released to Gunnison Fayette when Gunnison Reservoir is full and when flow from all sources combined exceeds their right (145 CFS) (111.35 CFS) as measured in the stream below the reservoir.

1930's Testimony: Storage in Gunnison Reservoir comes from Part of 145 CFS anything over 111.35/145 CFS they release downstream

Don't claim the right to carry water over from year to year, in Gunnison Reservoir.

Gunn. - Fay. vs. Gunn. 1968-69 Supreme Court ruling.
25 cfs. ahead of any rights Highland has on.
San Pitch, 6 mile, 12 mile.
Then. 15 cfs. after Highland filled.

Highland Rights. 1896 Priority - 85.62 cfs/40 cfs.
from San Pitch, Box (below Gunn. Res.).
Six Mile. (at confluence w/ Pittsford Canal)
12 Mile (at confluence w/ Highland Canal).

Current Gunnison Position = Water released to G.F.
when Gunnison Reservoir is full and when flow
from all sources combined exceeds their right
(145 cfs.) as measured in the stream below the Res.

1930's Testimony.

Storage in Gunn. Res. comes from part of 145 cfs.
(anything over $\frac{111.35}{145}$ cfs they release downstream).
