RE: AUTHORIZATION TO PUMP & IRRIGATE OUTSIDE DEFINED PERIOD OF USE
HARUICHI & TSUYAKO NARUSE - MILFORD VALLEY

Mr. Naruse:

Pursuant to your telephone call of this date, this letter is to authorize you to pump and irrigate outside the defined period of use for your water rights. As you explained, due to a pump failure during the latter part of the irrigation season, you have a crop of young hay which has not received irrigation for some time and is in danger of being lost. This authorization is given with the following conditions:

- 1) You will contact Commissioner Richard Jefferson and determine if you have unused water under your diversion allowances for the 1993 season. If so, your pumpage for the use now authorized will be limited to that amount still remaining under the current year's diversion allowance.
- 2) If you do not have sufficient water remaining in the current year's diversion allowance for your needs, you will arrange to lease the necessary water from the owner(s) of rights not presently in use and will promptly file a Temporary Change Application for use of the leased water. The leased rights cannot be rights with surplus diversion allowance, but must be rights which have not been used in the current year.
- 3) Your pumpage and irrigation under this authorization will be limited to that amount necessary for one irrigation cycle of the young hay crop in question and will be for the 1993 season only.
