Dear Messrs. Marshall: Re: Order to cease use of water Milford  
Area Distribution System

Last year, on March 6th, a notice was sent to all water users of the Milford Area Distribution System regarding the need for accurate and operational meters to be installed at each pumped well. In May, the wells in the area were inspected for compliance with the notice. The wells without operational meters were tagged by the water commissioner and the affected water users were ordered by the State Engineer to cease the use of water. Your well(s) were missed in our field inspection last year, so you did not receive any further notification from the State Engineer. However, at the annual water users meeting, held on February 10, 1993, the commissioner reported that your well(s) were not metered or the meter(s) are not working.

Therefore, by authority of Section 73-5-4 of the Utah Code Annotated, 1953, as amended, you are hereby ORDERED to cease the use of water from your well(s) until such time as meter(s) in good working condition have been installed at the well(s). Compliance with this Order will be determined by a field inspection by the River Commissioner in the near future. Those water users whose wells are not in compliance with the Order will be reported to the Attorney General's Office and legal proceedings will then be initiated to enforce this Order.

This Order is subject to the provisions of Rule R655-6-17 of the Division of Water Rights and to Sections 63-46b-13 and 73-3-14 of the Utah Code Annotated, 1953, as amended, which provide for filing either a Request for Reconsideration with the State Engineer, or an appeal with the appropriate District Court. A Request for Reconsideration must be filed with the State Engineer within 20 days of the date of this Order. However, a Request for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for a court appeal. A court appeal must be filed within 30 days after the date of this Order, or if a Request for Reconsideration has been filed, within 30 days after the date the Request for Reconsideration is denied. A Request for Reconsideration is considered denied when no action is taken 20 days after the request is filed.

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
