Re: Water Meters

Our inspection of the Milford Area Distribution System indicated approximately 100 out of 150 wells did not have meters that were working. I believe the wells belong to about 39 water users. You should have recently received a copy of the State Engineer's order that was sent to these water users. The order requires them to cease the use of water unless a water meter is installed.

We are in the process of following up on those letters and our next step will be to issue a notice of intent to start legal action from the Attorney General's office to those water users who have not complied.

Recently, we had a presentation in our office from a meter supplier, Disco Associates, Inc. One of the meters they carry may have some benefits over the Wheatland that several have installed in your area. I have given them the names of the water users who have received the order and your name, so you may receive a call from one of their salesmen.

I have received calls from several of the water users indicating it would be too much of a financial burden for them to install meters at this time. I have indicated to them that we were obligated to follow through with the order but we would work with them as much as possible. I told them that if they would submit to us a written plan for installing meters on their wells we would consider it.
