This Office first sent you a demand letter dated May 8, 1989 for payment of an assessment for the Milford Area Distribution System. Since that time, the State Engineer's Office has had various contacts with you. One such contact included a telephone conversation of September 9, 1990 where you agreed to pay the assessment.

As of this date, the assessment due is \$375.54 and is still unpaid. This Office has been instructed to refer this matter to the appropriate division to commence legal action unless satisfactory arrangements are made by December 7, 1990 with Lee Sim, 538-7380, of the State Engineer's Office. Any legal action will also demand that you pay the legal costs required to collect the unpaid assessment.

The State Engineer's Office has been very patient and now expects payment. Please work out a reasonable payment plan or legal action may commence.
