Dear Mr. Mayer:

This is the **SECOND NOTICE** that your account on the Milford Area Distribution System is delinquent in the amount of \$120.33 and has been delinquent since 1986.

Section 73-5-1, Utah Code Annotated, 1953, provides that distribution system costs shall be paid by the water users. Upon failure to do so, the State Engineer may forbid the use of the water by the delinquent water user, may create a lien upon the water right affected, and may foreclose such lien.

Pursuant to the provisions of the above statute you are hereby ordered and directed to cease the use of water from the Milford Area System unless this delinquent account is paid within 15 days.

If the account is not paid within 15 days, the River Commissioner will be directed to close your diversion works and place a State Engineer's Tag on it. If it is not physically practical to close the diversion works, a lien will be placed on the water right and proceedings will be started to foreclose the lien.

You are advised that under Sections 73-5-3 and 73-1-14 of the Utah Coded Annotated, 1953, the State Engineer's Tag is a legal document which places the tagged diversion wholly under the State Engineer's control. Further, anyone who unlawfully interferes with a diversion work or who interferes with a River Commissioner during the discharge of his duties is guilty of a misdemeanor and is liable for any damages.
