Dear Mr. Mayer:

Our records indicate the distribution assessments associated with your water right on the above distribution system have not been paid since 1986. **YOUR ACCOUNT IS CURRENTLY DELINQUENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$120.33** which includes current and previous years' assessments and delinquent penalties.

The water user assessments are used to pay the salary of the River Commissioner and the actual operating expenses of the distribution system as required by law (Sec. 73-5-1 of the Utah Code Annotated, 1953 as amended). The budget for these items is set at the annual distribution system meeting.

The law also states that upon failure to pay the assessment the State Engineer may create a lien on the water right, forbid the use of water, and take such court action as is necessary to collect the assessment.

The existence of the distribution system and the presence of a River Commissioner assure the orderly distribution of water according to the established priority schedules. The payment of your distribution assessment is important to the continued operation of the distribution system.

Therefore, **YOU ARE HEREBY REQUESTED TO PAY THE TOTAL AMOUNT DUE WITHIN 30 DAYS** or the State Engineer will have no alternative but to exercise the options stated above for non-payment.
