Dear Mr. McMullin:

We have been informed you are now the owner of the water rights associated with the water assessment Account No. 33-30b of the Milford Area/Escalante Valley Distribution System. L & W Ranch, through Mr. Lyle Wiseman, was the previous owner. We are, therefore, sending the assessment notice to you.

The distribution system is regulated by the State Engineer under authority of Section 73-5-1, Utah Code Annotated, 1953, as amended to insure orderly distribution of water based on water rights. A budget is set and assessments are made each year to meet the expenses of the distribution system including the commissioner's salary. The budget and assessments are set by the water users at the annual distribution meeting with the State Engineer. If assessments are not paid by June 1st, a delinquent penalty of 10% is added.
