Dear Mr. Leko:

Please find enclosed prints of aerial photography (35 mm slides) taken June 1996 of the Green Diamond Ranch. Scale of the prints is approximately 1 inch = 1000 feet. The resolution of the prints is not the quality of the original 35 mm slides, however you should be able to distinguish the irrigated fields at the time of the flight. I have also included digitized maps of the same area indicating the lands, which upon field examination, were being irrigated in August of the same year. (Areas cross lined in green show current irrigation, areas cross lined in blue show historic irrigation.)

My understanding is that you desire to know what lands and irrigation can take place under the existing water rights for the Green Diamond Ranch. The total water rights under 71-1244, 1093,1615, 1617, 1661, and 4447 are for 1089.50 acres.. A field examination of the Milford area in August indicates 840.40 acres currently under production, leaving 249.1 acres that could be added to your existing production.

Please note that the center pivot to the north is under water right 71-1244 for Sec. 25, T28 S R 11W. The other rights are for the contiguous pivots and farm area in Secs. 1 & 12, T29S, R11W. **If you desire to move water between the two farms, or elsewhere, a change application would need to be filed and approved through our Cedar City office.**
