

Milford Distribution System

1989 Minutes

James Mayer opened the meeting. The minutes of the 1988 meeting were read by Gerald Stoker. They were accepted by the water users. Lee Sim presented the 1988 Financial Report. Mr. Sim explained the effort which had been made to collect delinquent assessments in 1988. Statewide, there had been good response but not in the Milford area. The water users were disappointed that more had not been done. Mr. Sim explained the legal alternative available to the State Engineer for nonpayment of accounts and indicated the next step would be a letter from the Attorney General's office and a court order ordering payment. The Financial Report was approved by the water users.

Lee Strong presented the Commissioner's Report which included forecasts on the reservoir storage and the Beaver River. Four Hundred Forty wells were pumped in 1988. A motion was made, seconded and approved to accept the Commissioner's Report. Max made a motion to recommend Lee Strong as Commissioner for 1989. Russel Mayer seconded. The motion was approved by the water users. The system budget for 1989 was set the same as the 1987 budget except for an increase of \$35.00 to cover workmen's compensation and distribution insurance. Mike Yardley made the motion to accept the Budget and Max Mayer seconded. The motion carried. Max Mayer made a motion to forgive the delinquencies on accounts 35-B, 35-C, 35-D because the water rights had reverted to the original owner. Mike Yardley seconded the motion and it was approved by the water users. Max Mayer made a motion to keep the same officers as last year. It was seconded and approved.
