

MINUTES OF THE MILFORD WATER USERS MEETING - July 13, 1977

The meeting was called to order by James Meyer at 10:00 A.M. The minutes were read by ^(a) Donald Norseth.

Discussion of water meters and who is responsible for fixing them. It was agreed it will be up to the water user to work with Lee Strong to repair his own meter.

Discussion on temporary change vs. permanent change.

Discussion of crop survey on how this survey was made. Gerald Stoker reported that it was taken for aerial photo photos.

Discussion on over pumpage and who will turn the pump off. It will be an order from the Court to the farmer to turn it off.

As of June 25, 1977, 26% of the total water has been pumped.

If on your own Farm over pumpage occurs in one Area, a temporary change should be applied for to keep your records straight.

The State owns all water. The individual owns the right to use it.

To move water you must have land that is out of production. It is not possible to use unpumped water on other lands if you are farming 100% of your water right.

Discussion on how to handle the meter operation on sprinklers because the pressure is so great that it blows the gaskets.
