

MINUTES OF ANNUAL WATER USER'S MEETING
ESCLANATE VALLEY-MILFORD AREA



The meeting was called to order by Chairman James A. Mayer at 7:25p.m. on February 3, 1970 at the South Milford Community Club-house, Milford, Utah

Minutes of the 1969 meeting were read by the secretary and approved with no corrections.

Financial Report was read by Richard Paxton, Division of water Rights. Motion was made by Ted Rimpau to accept financial report as read, Seconded by Leon Paice, and the motion carried.

Lee Strong gave the commissioners report, including the condition of Minersville Reservoir, the water level standing at 47½ feet, and the surrounding area.

After some discussion on the budget Ted Rimpau made a motion to adopt a \$3050.00 budget. George Smith 2nd the motion and it carried.

Election of Officers for 1970 was the next item of business. Duane Yardley made a motion to retain the present officers and this motion carried.
