Gentlemen:

I am responding to your letter received in this office on March 6, 1995. I appreciate the progress that has been made in the Milford area. This office will continue to follow the progress until we feel that the court order is being followed.

We have initiated this same action in the Fillmore area. I currently only have staff to police these two areas. As soon as the situation is stabilized in one of these locations, we will be able to move on to another groundwater basin. We must have the manpower to back up what we order. Past experience indicates that unless we are in a position to take people to court, we get very little, if any, action.

I will commit that we will start to look at the water rights and land use pattern in the area. If from these investigations we observe expansions, action will be taken.
